Use the 'Pitch, prototype and pilot' structure

Pitch: "1 thing that could be useful is..."

Prototype: "It could look like this..."

Pilot: "1 way we could test this could be..."

At the end, measure and evaluate your results.



Label your experiments

Framing an activity as an experiment takes away the pressure of perfection and gives you permission to fail. This makes it much easier for other people to see and support new ways of working.
